




All About U.S.





Hold All the Cards This Summer

You have a library card, but do you have library cards? We'll lay ours on the table and tell you that we're pretty excited about our new KDL playing cards.

Playing cards have a rich and varied history, tracing their origins back to 9th century China. Initially known as the "leaf game," these cards spread to India, Persia and eventually Egypt, where the four-suit Mamluk deck was developed with suits of coins, cups, swords and polo sticks. By the late 14th century, playing cards had made their way to Europe, where they evolved into the familiar suits of hearts, diamonds, clubs and spades.

Did you know that playing cards also played a pivotal role in the development of library cataloging systems? During the French Revolution in 1791, the Revolutionary Government faced the challenge of organizing vast amounts of bibliographic information. Librarians ingeniously repurposed playing cards, which were blank on one side, to create the first library card catalogs. This innovative solution allowed them to efficiently manage and access their collections, laying the groundwork for modern cataloging methods.
