## Easy-to-Save Seeds

These are self-pollinating plants and rarely cross-pollinate by themselves. They need little or no separation between varieties, so you can grow different varieties and still easily save true seeds!

## Medium Difficulty Seeds

These are out-breeding plants, so varieties within the same species must be separated to avoid unwanted cross-pollination. Check with your neighbors about the varieties of plants they are growing!

## Advanced Difficulty Seeds

These are also out-breeding plants that must be separated, and require 2 years to produce seed (biennial).
