Play with your baby

- Use magnets to hold photos on the refrigerator and talk about them with your baby.
- Talk with your baby while preparing meals. Say aloud what you are doing.
- Use plastic bowls, measuring cups and plastic spatulas as fun toys for babies.
- Give your baby cubes of Jell-O to play with and sing: "Jell-O on the table, Jell-O on the table, wibble-wobble, Jell-O on the table!"
- Give your baby a muffin tin and fill each section with a treat or toy.
- Fill small plastic containers with cereal or uncooked rice and use a tight lid. This makes a fun rattle for baby to shake. Show your baby how to play and say "shake, shake" each time your baby shakes the container.

Talk and rhyme with your baby

Two little eyes to look around (point to eyes)

Two little ears to hear each sound (point to ears)

One little nose to smell what's sweet (point to nose)

One little mouth that likes to eat! (point to mouth)

Sing with your baby

Pat-a-cake, pat-a-cake, baker's man.

Bake me a cake as fast as you can

Roll it, pat it, mark it with a "B"

And put it in the oven for baby and me!
