SUCCESS BASICS

Pom-pom Sort and Count

Take a bunch of pom-poms and let your child sort them by color. Have your child count the pom-poms into cups and write the number of pom-poms on the cups.

What this is teaching:

- Your child is learning to differentiate between colors.
- Your child is counting objects – having something physical to count helps your child understand the connection between a number and “how many” make that number.
- Seeing numbers written helps your child know that the number means something.

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
