SUCCESS BASICS

Cut a bunch of different size shapes (big, medium size and little circles, squares, rectangles, triangles, ovals, stars, etc.). Have your child put all the circles together, all the squares, etc. Have your child put the shapes in order from either biggest to smallest or smallest to biggest.

What this is teaching:

- Your child is learning shapes (which will help them later as they learn to write the letters of the alphabet).
- Your child is learning descriptive words: big, small, medium, etc.
