SUCCESS BASICS

Whose Pile is Biggest?

Make two piles of similarly sized objects. Ask your child which has more (or less). Count the piles to see how many items are in each pile.

What this is teaching:

- a) Your child is learning that bigger piles tend to hold more things.
- b) After you've played a few times, your child can try to estimate the number of items in a pile, a skill they will use in school.
