
COMPREHENSION

Materials Needed: Two large circles (using this print-out, two hula-hoops, or strings in two circles.

Prompt your reader to talk about the books by stepping into each of the three parts when discussing the book. Talk about if the characters, problems, solutions, settings, or any other part were similar or different.
