WHAT IS BATTLE OF THE BOOKS (BOB)?

BOB is a competitive book trivia tournament for kids in grades 5-8 sponsored by the Grandville Branch of Kent District Library, in partnership with the Grandville Public Schools. BOB will be held virtually this year.

HOW DOES BOB WORK?

Participants form their own teams of 1-6 kids and they read five pre-selected books. With the guidance of their coach, each team hones their knowledge of the books and gets ready to compete with other BOB teams. Due to the pandemic, we are being very flexible with teams this year. Please determine on your own what size of team, method of practicing, etc. you are most comfortable with.

WHAT ARE THE BOOKS AND **HOW DO I GET THEM?**

Titles will be revealed online during the virtual BOB Kick-off. Missed the Kick-off? The video will be available to view on Facebook and Youtube afterwards. The books are available in the Grandville school media centers, as well as through KDL in print or digital formats.

WHO SELECTS THE BOOKS AND WHAT CRITERIA ARE USED?

A committee of librarians, teachers and school media staff choose the books based on factors such as kid appeal, genre balance, availability in paperback, level of difficulty, etc.

ARE THERE PRIZES?

Of course! The top three teams will receive prizes. The first place team keeps the BOB trophy, with their team name engraved, at their school for one year. There will be prizes for best team name
