Download the Libby app from your device's app store. Libby will walk you through the steps of finding your library and adding your library card!



To get started, head to Libbyapp.com in your web browser. Libby will walk you through the process of adding your library card!




Browse and Check items out in the Libby app:


- Open the Libby app on your mobile device.
- Browse your library's collection or search for a specific title or author.
- Borrow a title (you'll need to sign into your library to complete this step).
 - If all copies are currently checked out, click **Place a Hold** to be notified when your eBook is available.

- To borrow a book on the Libby app, tap **Borrow** under the title you'd like to check-out.

- Then tap **Borrow** again to borrow the title.

- Libby will ask if you'd like to read in the app or on a Kindle. Select your preferred way to read.










Browse and Check items out in your web browser:

- Click **Read or Listen now in browser** to open the book or audiobook in your browser.
- Click Download EPUB book to download an ebook to your computer, then transfer the book to a compatible ereader using Adobe Digital Editions. (Learn more about using Adobe Digital Editions with our Getting Started Guide).



An introduction to Libby: FAQ's

What do I need to sign-up for Libby?

To sign-up for Libby, you'll need an active Kent District Library card.

Which devices can I use Libby with?

You can access Libby through the Libby app on a mobile device (tablet or smartphone), or on the Libby website with a MacOS or Windows computer.

How do I get help with questions regarding Libby?

You can also get help directly from Libby through the app or their online help site at help.libbyapp.com.

How long are the lending periods?

Lending periods for eBooks and eAudiobooks from Libby are 3 weeks (21 days), .

Do I need to do anything to ensure items checked out in Libby are returned on time?

No, after the lending period, your digital loan will be automatically returned. If you finish reading or listening to a book early, you can return it early so the next patron can check it out!

QUICK TIP

You can navigate Libby using the icons at the bottom of the screen. To make navigation easier, change your settings so that Libby will display the name of the icon as well as the image. (This option is currently only available in English.)

- Tap on the **Menu** button.
- Open Settings
- Tap on Customize Navigation
- Under the **Navigation Bar** heading, toggle on **Labeled icons**
